



A Thorn In My Side

So to keep me from becoming proud, I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger from Satan to torment me and keep me from being proud.






PRIDE VS HUMILITY

Pride ends in humiliation, while humility brings honor.









PRIDE VS HUMILITY

Paul recognized that the answer to the potential of pride in his life was this thorn in his side.






What is the thorn in your side?




Three different times I begged the Lord to take it away. Each time he said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness."













So now I am glad to boast about my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ can work through me... For when I am weak, then I am strong. - 2 Corinthians 12:9-10



Paul's weakness in this world did not detract from but highlighted his strength in Christ.






The work God does in you and through you is not just for you.


Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honor.
