Notice The Names

Immanuel | God With Us (who He is)

Jesus | God Saves Us (what He does)

"Immanuel" reminds us that God looked down upon His people, in the midst of their dismay and despair, and sent Himself to dwell among them.

YES, God sees your pain.

"Jesus" reminds us that, in the midst of disdain and discord, God placed Himself on the sacrificial altar so that we may experience salvation.

YES, God cares about you.

For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.
